

Introduction:

In 2001 WAGGGS sent an appeal to their partners to finance the ‘building peace among children’ project throughout Africa.

Soroptimist International approached WAGGGS regarding cooperation between the two organizations, focusing on peace in Africa and working with children affected by conflict or violence.

In April 2004 an initial workshop was conducted in Kigali, Rwanda which was the first of its kind in Africa. The project is being implemented in thirteen other countries Kenya included. This project also fulfils the Millennium Development Goals set to be fulfilled by 2015 and they include promoting gender equality and empowering women which goes along with the WAGGGS mission statement.

Problem Statement:

Having already recruited over 500 girls to be Peace ambassadors at the Daadab Refugee Camp in North Eastern of Kenya and upon deliberations with the host community, the gatekeepers emphasized the need for physical empowerment on the girls.

Our goal:

To empower young girls and women perform their best even at the most difficult situations where resources may be limited.

Objectives:

To construct 3 open plan classes in the camps that can easily be subdivide occasionally to fit the activities.

To equip the classes with the necessary equipment.

To provide raw materials to be used during trainings
